So they will be great for interfacility transport of patients. WHEPP has offered ABLS classes on line and now offer an additional ABLS Hands On Course. 66 people have taken the Hands On Course and there will be additional courses available next year. Tracey is working on setting up Incident Command Center or Emergency Medical Operations training at the FEMA Training Center in Anniston AL.
